Important Information for the Start of the School Year




<u>Pre-Primary Orientation:</u> We are excited to invite you to our Pre-Primary Orientation on Wednesday, September 4th from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM. This orientation will provide you with valuable information about our Pre-Primary program, classroom environment, and daily routines. You will also have the opportunity to

meet your child's teacher and ask any questions you may have. Educators will reach out prior to this date

Class Lists and Classroom Configurations: We know you're eager to learn your child's class placement, and we appreciate your patience as we finalize the lists. Class configurations are still in progress and will be finalized by the end of September. Please refrain from contacting our administrative assistant or your child's current teacher about potential changes, as we cannot accommodate requests at this time. You'll receive detailed instructions from your child's teacher closer to the start of school.

BusPlanner: Everything you need to know about student transportation including eligibility, stop times and stop locations can be found on BusPlanner. Once you register and subscribe, you may also receive email notifications on changes to routes, bus delays or cancellations. To sign up, go to BusPlanner at hrce.mybusplanner.ca and click on Parent Portal. Follow the instructions to create an account. Don't have a BusPlanner Parent Portal account? Safety First: Visitor Protocol: The safety of our students and staff is our top priority. All visitors to the building, including volunteers and guests, must sign in at the office and obtain a visitor's tag from our administrative assistant. Please note that parents are not permitted in the building during instructional hours. If your child is being dropped off late or picked up early, they must be signed in/out at the office. Additionally, if someone other than a parent or legal guardian is picking up your child, that individual must be listed in PowerSchool.



<u>Universal School Lunch Program:</u> We're excited to launch the Universal School Lunch Program at HPCS starting October 28. In the meantime, lunches can still be ordered through the Tiny Feast portal on our website. New families should ensure their child is registered. Snacks will continue to be available for purchase at the lunch counter.
