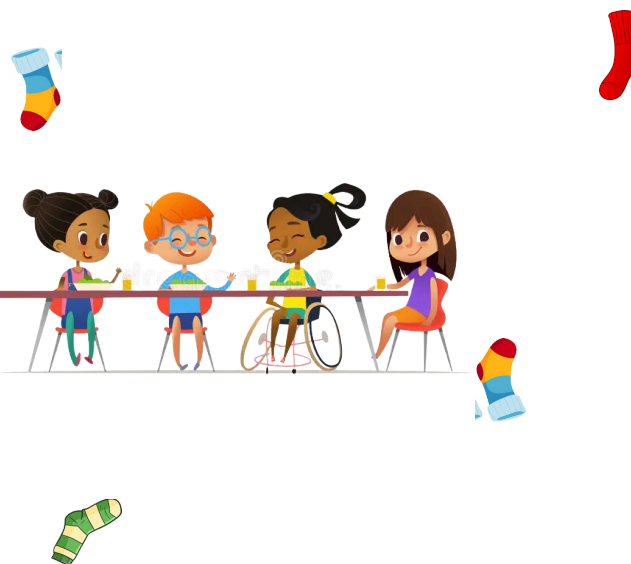
Grade 5 Sock Drive
